Subject: Showdown Half Marathon & 5K Run

On Saturday, October 14 2017, the 6th Annual Showdown Half (Marathon) and 5K run will take place in Fairview. Details of these races are listed below.

Race: Showdown Half Marathon & 5K Run

Date: October 14, 2017

Detail: 7:00 AM Radio Channel: CC PD1

Start: 7:30 AM (½ Marathon)

7:45 AM (5K Run)

End: 11:30 AM

Left on Elmbrook Drive Right on Tranquility Drive

(Route: See Below (Note: The 5K Run will begin @ 7:45 and will follow the same route as the 'Half' going out, until it reaches <u>Ridgeview Dr</u>. The 5K will then go south on Fairview Parkway to west on Indian Springs to west on Town Place Ext. to the finish line.)

Race events will begin NW of the front steps of Fairview Town Hall and follow the course below:

Route: ½ Marathon will follow the below route.

Northwest through the parking lot of town hall Right on Water Tower Way to Murray Farm Road Left on Murray Farm Road to Southwind Drive Right on Southwind Drive to US 75 SR Right on US 75 Service Road to Ridgeview Drive Right on Ridgeview Dr. for appx. 500' to Turnaround Right on US 75 Service Road to Frisco Road Right on Frisco Road to SH5 Right on SH5 to FM 1378 (Country Club Road) Left on FM 1378 to Stoddard Road Right on Stoddard Road Left on Hart Road Right on Tranquility Drive Right on Elmbrook Drive Left on FoxGlove Drive Left on Bending Oak Trail Merge onto Dewberry Lane

Right on Hart Road to FM 1378

Cross (FM 1378) Country Club to Red Oak Trail

Follow Red Oak Trail to Camino Real

Right on Camino Real to Alto Vista Drive

Right on Alto Vista to Cul-De-Sac and back to Camino Real

Right on Alto Vista to the Cul-De-Sac, around and back to Camino Real

Right on Camino Real back to Country Club (FM 1378)

Left on Country Club Road to Old Stacy

Right on Old Stacy to Stacy Road (FM 2786)

Right on Stacy Road (FM 2786) to Meandering Way

Right on Meandering Way to State Hwy 5

Left on State Hwy 5 to Indian Springs Road

Right on Indian Springs Road to Town Place Ext

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT

EXPECT DELAYS PLEASE DRIVE CAREFULLY EXPECT DELAYS.

The Fairview Police Department will utilize a combination of approximately sixty (60) police officers and race course volunteers to manage pedestrian and vehicular traffic along the race route.

** Race traffic will be very heavy along N. Country Club Road from SH5 to Stoddard from 7:45 until 8:30 a.m., along S. Country Club Road from 8:45 until 10:45 a.m., and along Stacy Road (FM 2786) from 8:50 until 10:50 a.m. due to one (1) lane Flagman traffic on these roads. **

Neighborhood entrance/exits affected by ½ marathon & controlled by police from 8:30 - 11:30 a.m. are:

Along US Highway 75 Service Road

Left on Town Place Ext. to the finish line

Northbound US 75 Service Road will be closed at Stacy Road from approx. 7:30 until 8:45 a.m.

Along Country Club Road

Flagman Traffic controlled through one (1) lane from Frisco Road to SH5 to Stoddard and again from Camino Real to Old Stacy Road.

Along Hart Road

@ Tranquility Farms traffic will be managed to exit to right or left depending on safety of runners. @ Fairview Meadows, Beechwood will be closed @ Hart Rd. @ Oakwood Estates, St. James will be controlled @ Hart Rd.

Along Stacy Road (FM 2786)

Flagman Traffic controlled through one (1) lane from Old Stacy (Prescott Rd on Allen side) to Meandering Way.

Along State Highway 5

- @ Bluebird Lane residents east of SH5 will use the Emergency Access Easement onto Hawkswood.
- @ Fairlanding Avenue will be open to exit/enter.
- @ Parkvillage may or may not be closed.
- @ Lakeridge Drive (The Domain) Traffic will exit using Stonebrook Dr. to Ambrym Dr. to Hawkswood Drive to Stacy Road. Vehicles may enter The Domain going northbound on SH5.
- @ Murray Road (Neighborhood residents will enter/exit here, Windmill Lane will be closed).
- @ Rosemont Ln (Cypress Crossing residents will enter/exit here. Brentley @ Meandering Way closed).
