

Residential Rain and Freeze Sensor Rebate Program

In order to encourage the conservation of water and to reduce run-off, specifically through the reduction of over-watering, the Town of Fairview has adopted a rebate program for rain and freeze sensors installed and utilized on residential irrigation systems.

To be eligible, a resident must have an active and up-to-date Town of Fairview residential utility account.

The program started on May 4, 2005; therefore, only approved irrigation systems installed on or after that date will be eligible for a rebate.

The residence must not already have a rain and freeze sensor device installed.

Only new, qualifying models of rain and freeze sensors will be eligible for rebate. A list of qualifying freeze sensors can be found online at www.fairviewtexas.org.

Applications must be received within 120 days of purchase, and must be submitted on an official completed town rebate form.

Rain and freeze sensor rebates will include the price of a qualifying rain and freeze sensor, installation hardware, and installation costs incurred by a licensed irrigator up to a maximum of \$50.00 per residential utility account.

All rebates are subject to the availability of funds during any given fiscal year. Requests will be processed and funded on a first-come, first-served basis.

Approved rebates shall be given in the form of a credit to the applicant's residential utility account.

No more than one rain and freeze sensor rebate per physical address shall be granted.

Homeowners' associations with current town utility service are eligible for one rain and freeze sensor rebate per water utility account.

The Town of Fairview does not require an irrigation permit to install a rain and freeze sensor.



Residential Rain and Freeze Sensor Rebate Form

Getting your rain and freeze sensor rebate is easy. Simply select, purchase, and install a new sensor from the qualifying list. Then, complete and mail (or drop off) this rebate application form, along with original copies of your receipt and proof of purchase. A town representative will visit your site within about thirty days to ensure the sensor is properly installed and functioning. If approved, your rebate, up to \$50.00, will show up as a credit on your water utility bill.

Rain and freeze sensors are required by ordinance for irrigation systems installed at all residential buildings platted after July 1, 2004, and therefore are not eligible for the rebate.

Devices indicated by * are single function only (rain OR freeze) and will require a companion device to be eligible for the rebate.
